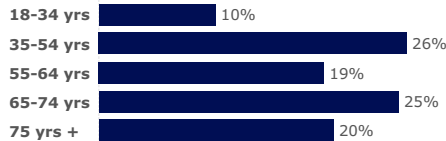

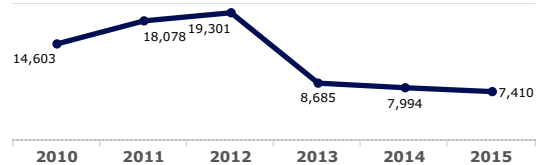

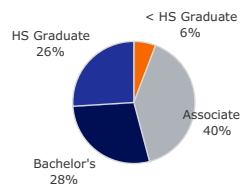

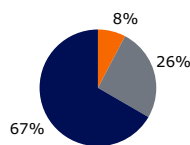

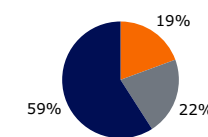

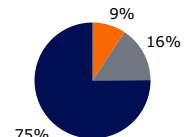
US Total Undergraduate Enrollment

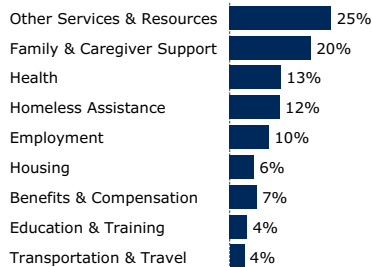

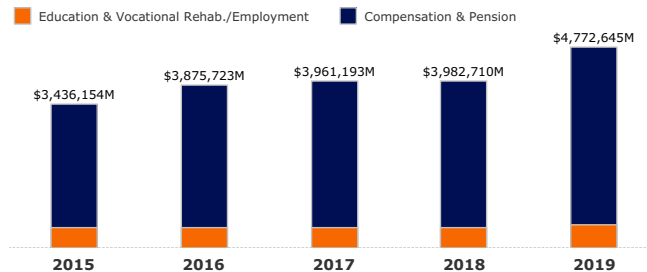
